Parkinsonia—a weed of national significance



Parkinsonia (*Parkinsonia aculeata*) is one of Australia's worst weeds—it has invaded over three million hectares.

Look out for this weed!

Parkinsonia:


- destroys wetland and floodplain habitats
- reduces biodiversity
- hinders stock management
- · restricts traditional use of land and rivers
- is primarily spread by water movement.







What can I do?



- Learn to identify parkinsonia.
- Identify potential sources of parkinsonia invasion (particularly upstream infestations).
- Monitor susceptible areas.
- Seek advice and implement a control plan.
- Coordinate control activities with neighbouring properties.
