Priorit

1

- Eradicate mimosa outside Northern Territory
- Implement surveys and map high risk areas and establish procedures for receiving, reporting (and monitoring) of infestations – early detection & response commitment.

Section 2.2

- Incorporate mimosa management at property, catchment and regional level supported by active compliance programs
- Continue to promote, implement and integrate adaptive best practice management programs at property, local and regional levels.

Section 2.4

- Continue to develop and promote tailored awareness, extension programs to suit target audience in all States & territories;
- Ensure key stakeholders are trained in mimosa identification, prevention and management aspects – reference to high priority strategic areas;

Section 2.1

- Ensure development of key mimosa management strategies that link to local govt and regional NRM organisation planning schemes
 - * Development and implementation of on-ground projects to support previous investments;
 - * Commit to active compliance to ensure follow-up & monitoring at all levels

- Relevant stakeholders undertaking active management programs to support eradication of mimosa in high priority strategic areas.

Section 2.2

- Encourage continual re-distribution of biocontrol agents.
- Refine current management techniques to reduce impact in sensitive areas.
- Update and distribute data on economic impact of mimosa to whole community.

Section 2.4

- Raise profile and awareness of mimosa across Northern Australia – NT, QLD and WA;

- Establish coordination, linkage and resource commitments across key stakeholders to maximise mimosa management
